**To cooperate** in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism, which makes possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism, and good will.

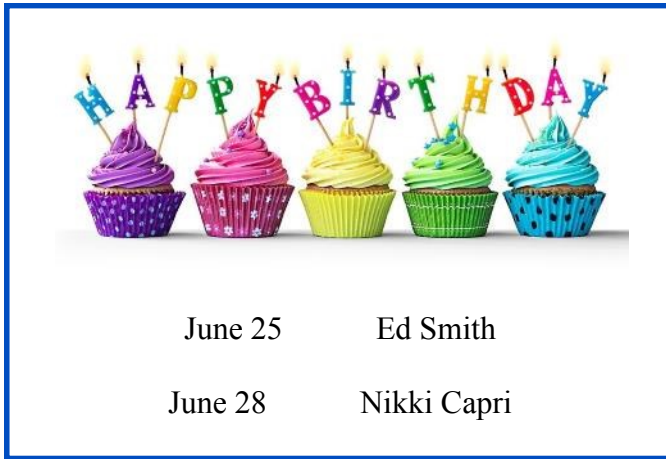

New Castle County Chamber of Commerce

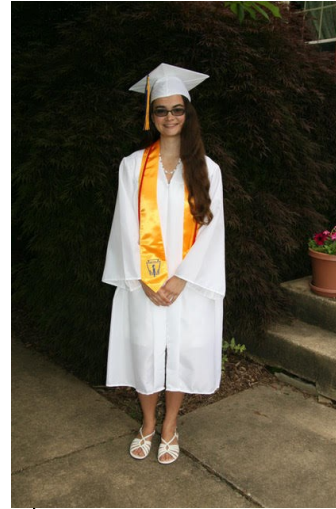


Mike Klienschmit became President of the New Castle County Chamber of Commerce in January of 2006. He is responsible for the management of the County's largest business trade organization with over 1,400 members. The Chamber provides a wide range of business assistance and networking programs for its members and maintains an active role in government relations at the local, state and federal level.

Since becoming President, Mark has undertaken a series of new initiatives including the relocation of the Chamber to a new headquarters facility, expanding the Chamber's economic development activities which included the establishment of a small business incubator program, the Emerging Enterprise Center, for early stage companies seeking to expand and create new jobs. Mark also manages the Chamber's Benefits Connection program, which provides health insurance to over 500 businesses.

Prior to joining the Chamber, Mark operated his own consulting company, MAK Associates, specializing in government relations, real estate development, and project management. He coordinated the planning and development of numerous business expansion projects and represented numerous clients in the Delaware General Assembly with a special focus on tax policy, gaming, affordable housing and economic development.

From 1999 to 2002, Mark was the co-founder and Chief Operating Officer of an internet start up company—FamousRadio.com. FamousRadio specialized in creating custom radio stations for in-store and online broadcasting. In launching the company as the COO, Mark interacted with various private investors and financial institutions, and in addition, he led business development activities with Fortune 500 companies throughout the United States.
